Estimado D. Mariano Rajoy,

La sociedad civil global pide la implementación de un amplio Impuesto sobre las Transacción Financieras (ITF) bajo mecanismo de Cooperación Reforzada Europea.

Le estamos escribiendo como representantes de la sociedad civil global para felicitarle, junto a los 10 otros países Europeos, por su decisión de implementar el ITF.

Le rogamos que se mantenga comprometido a introducir la ITF del modo más amplio posible cubriendo acciones, bonos y derivados (tal como fue sugerido por la Comisión Europea). Un ITF diseñado de dicha manera supondría€34 mil millones de ingresos – fondos necesarios para ayudar a proteger trabajos y servicios públicos, y para ayudar a asegurar que se cumpla con sus compromisos internacionales de luchar contra la pobreza, luchar contra el cambio climático y la promoción del desarrollo sostenible.

En las últimas semanas, el lobby financiero ha lanzado una serie de ataques al ITF. Estas son, en gran parte, historias de miedo generadas por el sector financiero que se está enfrentando a la realidad de tener que pagar por la crisis que provocó.

Le apelamos a mantenerse firme frente al lobby financiero, y en su lugar escuchar a las cientos organizaciones (que representan a miles de ciudadanos mundialmente) que están pidiendo un ITF amplio que aporte mayor estabilidad al sector financiero y recaude miles de millones en ingresos para ayudar a los que más han sido afectados por la crisis.

Siendo un pionero del **Impuesto sobre las Transacciones Financieras**, Ud. está poniendo un importante precedente para que otros países puedan dar el paso histórico que Ud. está dando.
